


THE POWER OF OUR MISSION

We unite young people (Littles) with caring, positive adult role models (Bigs) in professionally supported one-to-one mentoring friendships.

Together, they clear a path to success by breaking societal barriers, closing opportunity gaps and overcoming adversities like poverty and identity-based discrimination.

Our evidence-based program builds social and emotional support, confidence and resilience that help to ensure young people:

- » Are college and career ready
- » Have a healthy physical and mental wellbeing

Beyond School Walls matches Littles with a workplace mentor, introducing youth to a professional environment, building soft skills and developing a plan for future success.

Bigs in Blue builds friendships that opens lines of communication between youth and local law enforcement officers.

HS Bigs are High school students learning leadership skills while volunteering as mentors at nearby elementary and middle schools.

Justice. Equity. Diversity. Inclusion. (J.E.D.I.) programming creates learning experiences and empowers youth voices. Includes the HBCU Fair and D.E.I. Youth Leadership Summit.

Youth Rise: Stand Together allows students to have meaningful interactions with professionals of color and address issues of racial inequality.

Savvy Sisters helps girls explore professional and academic interests through visits to area businesses and organizations.
